Case Study

RetailROI joins *Free for Life International* in its commitment to rescue and restore victims of human trafficking and eliminate modern-day slavery.

An estimated 1,000 girls a month are trafficked from Nepal to India, many through the Krishnanagar border station. Lured with the promise of a job, they are often drugged and put on a bus, only to awaken and find they have been sold to an Indian brothel.

Free for Life International, in partnership with Peace Rehabilitation Center in Nepal, are on the front lines of the human trafficking battle through the monitoring of the Nepalese Krishnanagar border station.

A grant from RetailROI has been instrumental in Free for Life International's partnership with Peace Rehabilitation Center (PRC), both at the Krishnanagar border and at PRC's main shelter home. In 6 months alone, PRC staff counseled 1,741 women and children on the dangers of trafficking; rescued 37 young women from trafficking; and captured 3 human traffickers. All of those rescued received support, shelter, services, and love through PRC's main shelter in Nepal.

For more than 20 years, PRC has been combating trafficking at its root sources - primarily poverty and illiteracy. Their programs include border monitoring, to prevent girls from being taken out of the country; education of girls at risk through community training; counseling; vocational training; and economic assistance through donations of goats and cows to economically empower the girls. In addition to the success of these programs, they are responsible for the capture of over 25 traffickers at the border crossings alone.
